Light and darkness are elemental concepts that engender a multiplicity of meanings and experiences, in both figurative and metaphorical terms. They coexist like the symbol of yin and yang; and follow universal systems that we understand from the very way our cosmos is arranged. The compilation of photographs from Amita Talwar's diverse body of work, reflects on the intermingling of darkness and light, and the subtle relationships of concealment and revelation that it makes visible. Talwar's images often embrace the subject of Transience – the ephemerality and impermanence of both physical and intangible entities. In a period of disorientation like the current times, the relevance of acknowledging this in-betweenness, and finding a way to balance between extremities, is a valuable message.

Beuys, the man with a hat, some felt, and the Fettecke. Thirty years after his death he still seems to be a visionary, way ahead of his time. Back then he was trying to patently explain how “money shouldn’t be a commodity.” He knew that money trade would undermine democracy. But there’s more. Beuys lectures and explains pictures to a dead hare. He asks with a grin: “Do you want a revolution without laughter?” His expanded concept of art leads him smack in the middle of socially relevant discourse, even today.
