FASSBINDER - LIEBEN OHNE ZU FORDERN

(FASSBINDER: TO LOVE WITHOUT DEMANDS)

A film by Christian Braad Thomsen

2015 · Documentary · 1h 49m

The film "Fassbinder: To love without demands" takes a Freudian lens to the life and career of the seminal filmmaker. Friend and devotee of Fassbinder from 1969 to the end, Thomson runs through the director's career with a psychoanalytic bent, supported by an unreleased interview he shot in 1978 when the great man was particularly exhausted and loose-lipped. Thomsen divides his docu into chapters — "Childhood," "The Adult Child," etc. — to further emphasize the psychoanalytical underpinnings, especially with regard to Fassbinder's earliest years.

LYARI NOTES


A film by Maheen Zia and Miriam Chandy Menacherry 80 minutes, 2015-16, India and Pakistan, Hindi /English with English Subtitles

Summary: In Pakistan a rock star teaches a group of girls to express themselves through music in Karachi's most volatile district. Hamza Jafri travels in an armed vehicle. He is a musician famous for his hard hitting political lyrics since the 1990s. Since then religious fundamentalism has been on the rise with shops selling music torched, concerts bombed and musicians threatened with death. Seeing the shrinking space for music and artists Hamza opens a music school. Captured over 3 years Lyari Notes is the narrative of four young girls who attend Hamza's music school and learn what it takes to express oneself despite the cycles of violence.
