Pygmy hog, the world’s smallest and rarest pig: An insight into its biology and conservation by Deepanwita



Pygmy hog is a critically endangered species which is endemic to the grasslands of South Himalyan foothills. Once ranged over the entire Himalyan states, is now restricted to only a single wild population in Assam due to habitat loss. The present talk will cover the behavioural ecology of this illusive animal in its native habitat and throw lights on the conservation breeding program being undertaken to save the animal from extinction.
