## KUNSTFORUM - ART TALK (ONLINE)

Learning to Look: Indian Art History and the German Legacy by Dr. Sarada Natarajan Ph. D., Art Historian





From what perspective do we approach works of art in a gallery, museum or historical monument? Is there a common lens through which we view all works of visual art or do we need to change our lenses each time we encounter artworks from a different culture? What differentiates art from heritage?

Learning to Look is the first in a series of seven Kunstforum lectures that will attempt to answer the question 'What do Art Historians Study?' in the context of the discipline's evolution in India. The focus will be on the contributions of six influential German art and cultural historians from the 18th through the 20th centuries and how their core theoretical formulations can be adapted and applied to the study of Indian art.
