The Indian Photo Festival (IPF) - Hyderabad, a Not-For-Profit initiative of Light Craft Foundation is India's longest running international photography festival showcasing a wide range of photography from India and around the globe with a series of events including: talks and discussions, portfolio reviews, screenings & workshops. The IPF creates a platform for the professional and aspiring photographers, the photography lovers and the public where the festival promotes the art of photography and at the same time addresses the social issues through the medium of photography.

Due to the ongoing pandemic Covid-19, the Indian Photo Festival will be presented from 12th November to 13th December, in an altered, yet adapted format - largely ONLINE - with all the Interactive Sessions via Virtual Platforms. The PRINT Exhibitions will be installed along the lush green, outer walking trail of the picturesque KBR Park located in the heart of the city of Hyderabad. Digital Exhibitions will be showcased at The State Gallery of Art, Madhapur and some fascinating Virtual 3D Exhibitions will be presented online.

In the words of the Photographer: "The street is open for anyone to see. With my camera, I capture my own perspective of the situation. Street Photography gives me great freedom to express my point of view and to me, this is art. There is no restriction to street photography. For instance, unlike landscape photography, it is not necessary to travel to a particular destination or place so as to capture the scene. Street Photography moments happen everywhere as soon as we step out of our house."



Siegfried Hansen

Siegfried Hansen is from **Hamburg**, **Germany**. His distinctive style has earned him recognition both nationally and internationally. He is one of the photographers featured in the book "Street Photography Now". Siegfried's work has been widely exhibited, including solo exhibitions in Germany and group exhibitions in Europe and the United States.

Siegfried has been a speaker and a juror at many photo festivals around the world. In 2015 The German Kettler Verlag published his very successful book: "Hold The Line" and he then served as a Mentor at the "Master of Photography" TV Show on Sky Arte in 2017. He published his book "The flow of lines" in 2020.

This exhibition will be on view at Goethe-Zentrum Hyderabad; our first exhibition in the physical spaces since the outbreak of the pandemic. Hence all visits would be scheduled by appointment only*. Once at the premises, visitors are requested to comply to all safety guidelines of COVID-19: temperature check, sanitization regulations, safe distancing, a mask etc.






