The Science Film Festival is a celebration of science communication in Southeast Asia, South Asia, Africa, the Middle East and Latin America: In cooperation with local partners it promotes science literacy and facilitates awareness of contemporary scientific, technological and environmental issues through international films with accompanying educational activities. The Science Film Festival presents 122 films from 22 countries as the international official selection in 2021.

Theme of the Year 2021 is Health and Wellbeing. In the context and aftermath of the pandemic, health and mental well-being are more important than ever. Many children and youths in particular may be struggling, they may be worried about maintaining their own wellbeing or want to better equip themselves to help loved ones. That is why bringing these issues out into the open especially at this time is so important and why the Science Film Festival turns its focus on the science of health and wellbeing in 2021 with a selection of international films on these topics.

"NOT THE ONLY GAY IN THE CITY"

A digital photo exhibition

CARSTEN BRUHN

07 October - 06 November 2021

"What is a relevant location of your queer biography?" was the question raised to 50 gay men in Hamburg by Carsten Bruhn as he was putting together his first big photo project.

Men of different ages and whereabouts, most of them living in Hamburg now, had told him their stories. Stories of their coming-out, their self-discovery, stories of fear and courage, of gay shame in a heteronormative world, of suppression and liberation. Taking part in his project to them was in fact also an expression of their self-portrayal as a gay man, and is indeed a visible expression of their pride. And of them knowing: They are not alone, they are most certainly "Not the Only Gay in the City!"

Carsten Bruhn, born in Kiel in 1965, moved to Hamburg in 2001 and since 2013 he has been married to his husband. He claims to lead two lives. One as a full-time teacher, full of energy and passion for his dream job. The other as a photographer. Humbly declaring of him being an amateur and basically an autodidact, he pursues his "hobby" with just the same amount of energy and passion. He sees through his lens, with or without camera.
