






INTERNATIONAL MOTHER LANGUAGE DAY

THE CLEANERS

A film by Hans Block and Moritz Riesewieck

The big Internet companies, not all which can properly be described "social media", are drowning in the unending flood of online content. From hate mail to pornography, from depictions of child abuse to manipulated war pictures used for propaganda, the necessity for preventive action is growing – if only to avoid damaging one's own public image. As a rule, however, this task is not normally performed by the corporations themselves: "outsourcing" is the cheapest solution as well as the most comfortable – and the contracted companies are also responsible for any corresponding mistakes. The result is that in Manila, for example, an untold number of poorly trained and quickly psychologically-impacted "moderators" sit long hours in front of their computer screens and, in accordance to highly schematic and American criteria, use the delete key to wage war against objectionable content on the Internet. The documentary focus of THE CLEANERS is primarily on the work they do, but also looks at the related debate in the USA.

KARBALA MEMOIR

A film by Sourav Sarangi

Prophet Muhammad's grandson Hussain knew that he would be killed the next day. His caravan with a retinue comprising approximately hundred companions and some animals was surrounded by an army of thousands. Despite his requests to be left alone, his family and followers refused to desert him. Husain, along with most of his family members who had wanted justice from the Syrian dynasty, had to pay with their lives at the battle of Karbala in October 608 AD. This event would have remained a footnote in the pages of human history had it not been for the annual Arba'een Walk where millions of pilgrims visit Karbala by foot to pay homage to Hussain's sacrifice. This film looks at Hussain's martyrdom from the perspective of an Indian who accidentally happens to be in the ancient land that has been ravaged by war, extremism and autocracy. The narrative merges his childhood memories with immensely disturbing contemporary realities.
