
SANG O SHAYARI

TRANSNATIONAL COMMERCIAL SURROGACY IN INDIA

WOMEN'S EXPERIENCE WITH PHYSICAL, EMOTIONAL & MONETARY IMPACT WITH DR. SHEELA SURYANARAYAN | 29 JULY 2022



India had become a transnational surrogacy market with mushrooming In-vitro Fertilization clinics and surrogacy hostels all over the country. The Surrogacy (Regulation) Act 2021 prohibits commercial surrogacy in India after reports of deaths of surrogate mothers and egg donors, trafficking and exploitation of women and children, children stranded and abandoned and rampant unethical practices. Taking poverty as the primary analytical axis, I examine the impact of surrogacy on 45 surrogate mothers in India.

Feminists Gena Corea (1985) and Andrea Dworkin (1983), cautioned that commercial surrogacy market would move to the poorer countries in the third world for a lesser cost. Women as surrogate mothers in India are known to be from poor-income households from the Global South with lower educational attainment and lesser employment opportunities. The transnational surrogacy market represents both post-colonialism and neo-colonization of women's body. This racialized body market treats women's 'body-space' as 'risky', 'polluting' and 'discard-able'. My study revealed that the poorest remained in abject poverty, while the land/house-owners became richer post-surrogacy. Loans taken by 'poor' and 'very poor' households increased post-surrogacy.

The 'poor' repeated surrogacies and also experienced the health impact of surrogacy. The 'poor' and 'very poor' women were adversely affected financially, health-wise and emotionally post-surrogacy.

About Dr. Sheela Suryanarayan: Sheela Suryanarayanan is a Social Science specialist in reproductive health and has conducted research on maternal and child health, surrogacy, sex selective abortion and prenatal screening. Her book, on surrogacy is titled, 'A Transnational Feminist View of Surrogacy Biomarkets in India'(Springer, 2018). She has given her expert inputs to the Rajya Sabha, Select Committee on Surrogacy Chaired by Shri Bhupender Yadav before the finalization of The Surrogacy (Regulation) Act 2021. She is currently Associate Professor at the Centre for Women's Studies, School of Social Sciences, University of Hyderabad.
