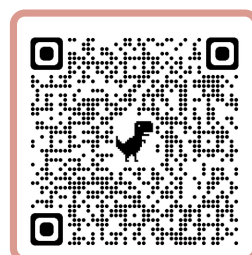

75 YEARS of India's Independence!

As India celebrates her 75 Years of Independence, we become acutely aware once again of two wholly different countries and their parallel trajectories over the last eight decades. India emerged from the shackles of British colonialism, the gravely battered Germany was resurrecting itself post World War II we witness India and Germany leading from the front. It is the convergence of the two nations that draw our attention in the present times.

Interestingly, the national anthem, Jana Gana Mana Adhinayaka Jai Hei, composed by Rabindranath Tagore was first performed with a full German orchestra in Hamburg in September 1942, under the auspices of Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose, much before it was officially declared as such by the then President of India.

Germany and India have forged diplomatic ties since 1951 and promoting actively scientific, cultural, educational, and business exchange. While German language teaching started well over 100 years ago in Pune in 1914, the first cultural and educational institutions were established within 10 years of independence. The basis of the Indo-German cultural exchange is the Cultural Agreement between the Federal Republic of Germany and India that came into force in September 1969. The Agreement establishes the foundation of cooperation in the field of culture and education between Germany and India.

The German Academic Research Service was established in New Delhi in 1960 and now oversees a consortium (The German Centre for Research and Innovation - DWIH) with 20 academic, research, funding bodies, and institutes of higher learning from Germany to further and facilitate mobility of students and academia of both countries. These organizations work closely with leading Indian universities and ICMR institutes.

The cultural and educational network continues to be expanded and enriched by the presence of Goethe-Zentrum such as ours. Goethe-Zentrum Hyderabad was launched in 2004 followed by four others soon after.

As such, India's journey has been magnificent and meaningful, and as we celebrate, it is time to pause and ponder, to look ahead, to look within, and also beyond. It may well be time to revisit trajectories with our friends and partners and realign priorities and overall efforts to establish peaceful coexistence across continents.

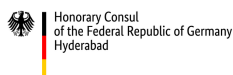
