



The UEFA European Championship, held every four years, is one of the most prestigious football tournaments in the world, second only to the World Cup. It features national teams from the Union of European Football Associations (UEFA) member countries.

The first European Championship, initially called the European Nations' Cup, took place in 1960, starting with 17 teams competing over two years. The final tournament featured four teams. By 1980, it expanded to eight teams and grew to 16 teams in 1996. West Germany won the Championship in 1972, 1980, and again in 1996 after the reunification of East and West Germany.

This year, Germany is hosting the 17th edition of the Championship, chosen at a UEFA Executive Committee meeting. While West Germany hosted in 1988, this is Germany's first time as a reunified nation. Matches will take place in ten venues across the country, with the grand final set for Berlin's Olympia Stadium at 12:30 am IST on Monday, July 15, 2024!

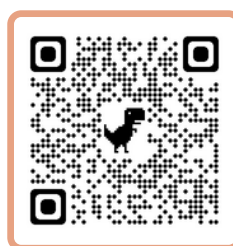

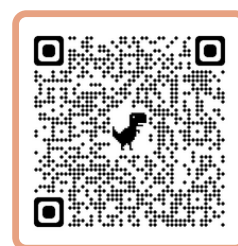

In this visually stunning film, directed by Burhan Qurbani, Francis, played by Welket Bungué, is an undocumented immigrant who arrives in Berlin with high hopes and the intention of being a decent person. But both the city and circumstances are against him. The film is based on Alfred Döblin's classic novel of the same name.

The story is about Franz Biberkopf, an immigrant named Francis, who has fled Guinea-Bissau to start a better life in Europe. After he survives both a storm and shipwreck, he vows to become a decent person. Arriving in Berlin, he makes a sincere effort to fulfill this oath, but his friendship with the drug dealer Reinhold and the social conditions in Germany stack the deck against him. He's able to draw hope from his love for Mieze, played by Jella Haase.

Berlin Alexanderplatz is a lovely film that, instead of strictly following the classic book, tells a modern and expressive story that fits today's world.

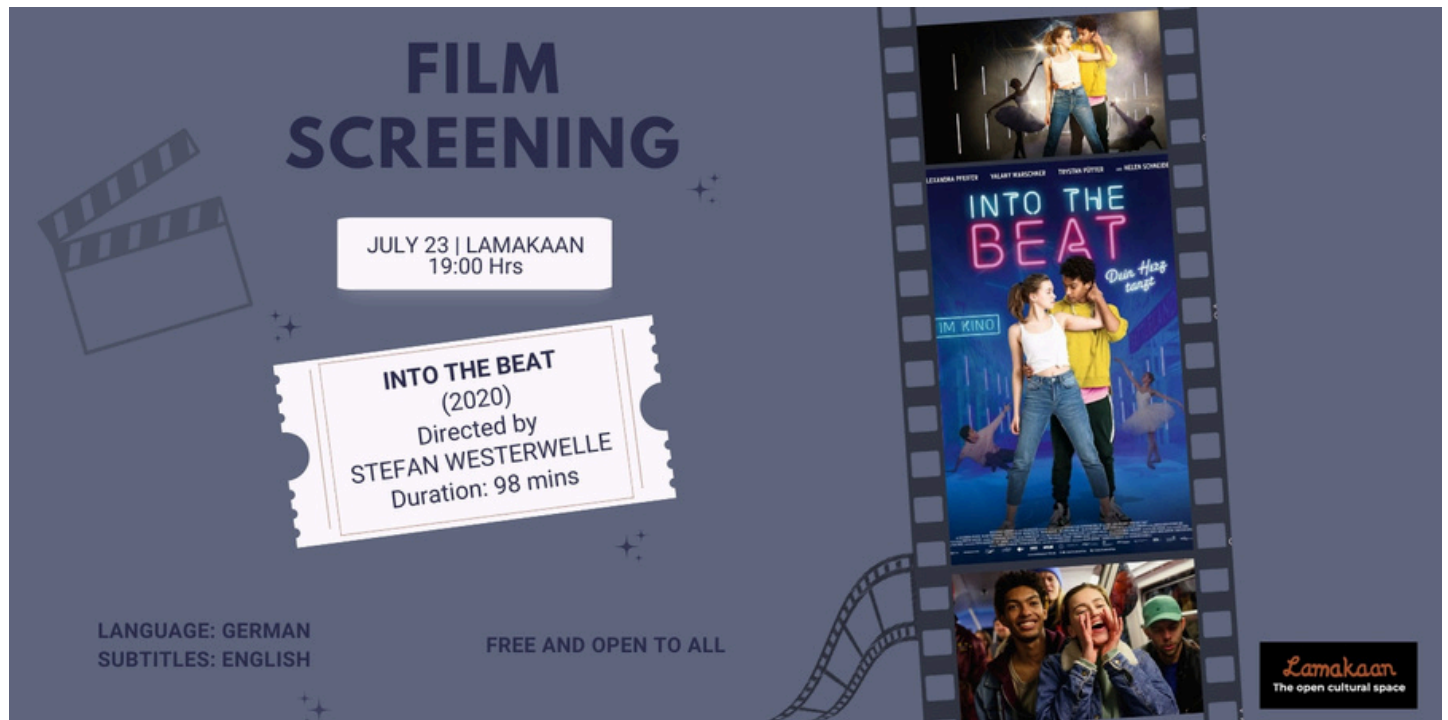
MOVIE SCREENING

INTO THE BEAT

A film by Stefan Westerwelle

Into the Beat is a beautiful film, directed by Stefan Westerwelle where teen ballerina Katya, played by Alexandra Pfeifer, discovers hip-hop by chance and is faced with an impossible choice: Does she follow her parents' footsteps... or her newfound passion?

For Hamburg ballet student Katya, the hard training for a scholarship at the New York Ballet Academy is almost a matter of course, as she is the daughter of Victor Orlow, a celebrated ballet dancer who, after the death of his wife, is now looking after Katya and her younger brother Paul on her own. There are only three weeks left until the exam under the merciless regime of the dance teacher. One day, however, Katya discovers a factory hall on her way where people are dancing – albeit to completely different sounds and with impetuous acrobatic movements. She immerses herself in this young, wild hip-hop dance scene, feels free, is recognized, and meets the dancer Marlon, played by Yalany Marschner. The more she feels that this is her form of expression, the more she comes into a conflict of conscience with her beloved father, who can no longer dance since an accident on stage. The daughter, however, feels obliged to continue the ballet tradition in the family. Katya has to make a decision.

Over a period of twelve months, the film series **“City, Country, River”** takes you through various places and regions in Germany. The depiction of the realities of German life in films and series formats is mainly influenced by large cities such as Berlin, Munich or Cologne. However, it alone cannot capture the geographical breadth of life in Germany. A significant part of life takes place in the numerous small to medium-sized cities and in rural areas.

The film series represents an alternative to the cinematic dominance of well-known large cities and embarks on a twelve-month journey through various underrepresented areas of Germany. It thus offers an opportunity to engage with the multifaceted depictions of everyday life and challenges as well as questions of identity and relationships of the people living there. The selected films invite reflection on the diverse realities of life in the country and insight into the complexity of German filmmaking. The stories of the places and their residents unfold against unknown backdrops, dealing, among other things, with non-conformity, the negotiation of role models and family conflicts. Universal topics are addressed in specific local contexts: the relationship between town and country or questions of coexistence.

HIGHLIGHTS FROM JUNE



This 'n That

A lovely heart-warming German recipe to try during the upcoming monsoons: Flammkuchen. The recipe originated in the once-German region of Elsass in France and is also called Tarte Flambée.

Flammkuchen is found at Biergartens and even at Oktoberfest in Munich. It is enjoyed as a snack, appetizer, or entrée and it is also common to eat an individual Flammkuchen.

Flammkuchen is an onion flatbread or pizza with a sour cream base. Traditionally, it was topped with bacon bits, but feel free to skip them and turn it into a vegetarian recipe.

Ingredients for Dough:

- 200 grams flour
- 2 Tablespoon Olive Oil
- ½ teaspoon salt
- ½ cup water

Toppings:

- 200 grams sour cream
- 60 milliliters heavy whipping cream
- 200 grams yellow onion about 1 large onion, cut into thin rings
- 100 grams bacon thick cut, cut into small strips (lardons) or diced (optional)
- salt and pepper
- 50 grams gruyère cheese (optional)

INSTRUCTIONS:

- Preheat the oven to the highest temperature (260° Celsius) and if you have a pizza stone, feel free to use it. Baking it on a baking sheet covered with parchment paper also works.

Make The Dough:

- Mix together all the dough ingredients. If it's still sticky, add some more flour until you are able to work it with your hands. If it's too dry, add some more water.

Prepare the Toppings:

- Mix together the sour cream and heavy whipping cream. Add in some shredded gruyère for an added flavor, which is non-traditional. Season to taste with some salt and pepper.

Assemble & Bake:

- Roll out the dough thinly and spread out the sour cream mixture on it using a spoon.
- Evenly distribute the onion rings and cut up bacon (optional).
- Bake for about 15-20 minutes or until the crust starts becoming golden. Feel free to garnish with chopped, fresh herbs like chives and parsley.
